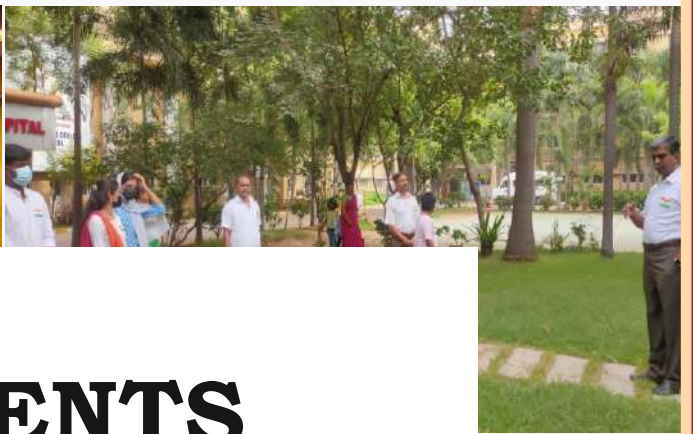

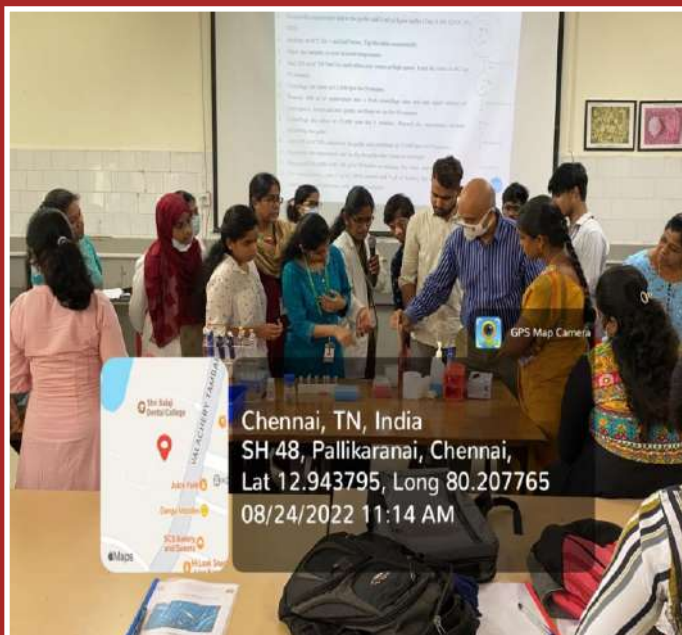

CASE OF THE MONTH



Dr. T V Rajalakshmi Rakshanaa

A 49-year-old male patient was referred to the Oral Medicine clinic by a dental practitioner with chief complaints of burning sensation in the mouth. History revealed multiple painful blisters which ruptured to form ulcers in the mouth and lips subsequent to the intake of medications, following a tooth extraction 4 days ago. Patient was on anti- hypertensive medications for the past 15 years



On clinical examination extra-orally, there was severe crusting of upper and lower lips with multiple eroded areas. White to greyish necrotic slough were present all over the upper and lower lips and also the commissures of lips bilaterally which readily bled on touch. On intra-oral examination multiple superficial ulcers were seen with irregular margins on the lateral surface of the tongue bilaterally and on anterior two-third of ventral surface of tongue, on the left side of hard palate and left retromolar region. There was no involvement of other mucosal and dermal surfaces.



Routine haematological investigations were within the normal range. Based on the positive drug history, acute onset and clinical presentation a clinical diagnosis of Drug induced Erythema Multiforme was given.

Management

Patient was advised to discontinue all medications. Patient was prescribed with Systemic steroids (Oral prednisolone) 5 mg thrice a day initially for 3 days and the dose was increased to four times a day for next 3 days after which tapering of the medication was done for the next one week.

1 week follow up

Partial healing on lips, tongue was seen and Complete healing of erosions was seen on hard palate.



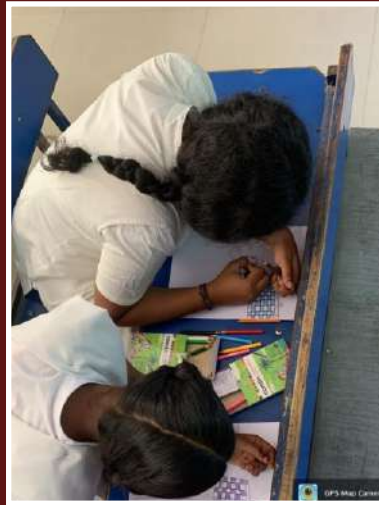
2 week follow up

Complete healing of lesions seen extra-orally and intraorally with post inflammatory pigmentation on lips.

जाती है। एक्सोडेंट में सबसे ज्यादा जबड़ा टूटता : चेन्नाई से आए डॉ. एस जिमसन ने कहा कि एक्सोडेंट में सबसे ज्यादा जबड़ा टूटने की घटनाएं हो रही हैं। साइरस मिस्त्री की मौत ने कई सवाल सामने रख दिए हैं। एक्सोडेंट में 63 फेसटो घायलों का हेलमेट-सील्ट वेल्ट न लगाने से ही जबड़ा टूटता है। वह एसोसिएशन का भी सर्वे भी कह रहा है जबकि आपस की मारपीट में मुक्केबाजी में 22 फेसटो का जबड़ा टूटता है। इसी तरह सिर्फ 4 फेसटो एक्सोडेंट आकारा पशुओं की कजह से होते हैं जिसमें जबड़ा डैमेज होता है। इसलिए अब देश भर के जबड़ा-चेहरे और डेंटल सर्जनों ने कार में सभी सीटों पर सील्ट वेल्ट अनिवार्य करने का सुझाव केन्द्र सरकार को दिया है।
