RULES AND REGULATIONS OF EVENTS

1. PAPER PRESENTATION :

1. Five teams per college.
2. One or Two students per team.
3. Presentation for 6 mins, Discussion for 2 mins
4. All presentations are to be submitted in PowerPoint format.
5. Make sure your slides are sized for On-screen show with orientation set at Landscape. Format is 16:9 (wide screen).
6. Avoid busy background and lengthy or animated slides transitions.
7. Import pictures and photos in standard formats: .jpg, .gif, or .tif.
8. Evaluate the size of scanned images you import. Your image resolution need not be higher than your laptop screen.
9. To help simplify slides consider the following:
 - a. Convey only one main idea per slide.
 - b. Use pictures, simple diagrams, graphs or tables where possible rather than text.
 - c. Not exceed more than 6 lines per slide..
10. The decision of the judges will be final and binding.

2. e-POSTER PRESENTATION

1. Five teams per college.
2. One or Two students per team.
3. 4 mins presentation, 1 min question/answer session.
4. Name of the Candidate, Guide and college must not be mentioned.
5. Code number provided by organisers must be visible in the lower bottom right corner of slide.
6. Dimensions - Landscape layout mode - 16:9 widescreen format.
7. The decision of the judges will be final and binding.

3. TABLE CLINIC

1. Two Teams per college, Each Table Clinic can accommodate between two to four students.
2. 30 minutes time will be given for arrangement of Table clinic presentation
3. The Presenters will have 4 minutes to present their work, followed by a 2-minute discussion.
4. Each team will be provided with one table for display.
5. The decision of the judges will be final and binding.

4. QUIZ

1. Participants - INTERNS/CRRl
2. Topic: Dentistry.
3. Two teams per college, Three students per team.
4. Any prompting or assistance from the audience will result in the disqualification of the respective college.

5. DEBATE

1. Two teams per college.
2. Two students per team.
3. One team for, and one team against,- Topic.
4. 2 minutes per round.
5. Any use of offensive language or inappropriate content will result in immediate disqualification.
6. The decision of the judges will be final and binding.

6. REELS: Theme - Robot Dentists: Bye-Bye, Humans?

1. Each team must have 5 students only.
2. The Reel should be between 30 to 60 seconds.
3. Must be original, appropriate, and align with the given theme.
4. Video should be in vertical (9:16), HD quality, and in MP4/MOV format.
5. Any use of offensive language or inappropriate content will result in immediate disqualification.
6. Judging – Based on creativity, relevance, editing, engagement, and performance.
7. The decision of the judges will be final and binding

7. ADZAP COMPETITION

Event Overview: Adzap is an engaging and innovative competition designed for undergraduate dental students to creatively present and advertise dental materials in an entertaining and informative manner. Participants will utilize humor, creativity, and effective communication to convey key aspects of their assigned material.

1. This is a team-based event.
2. Each team may consist of up to six (6) participants.
3. A maximum of two teams per college are permitted.
4. Topics will be centered on dental materials.
5. Each team will draw their topic by lot at the registration desk.
6. Only one representative per team may pick the lot.
7. The presentation should be between three to five minutes.
8. Exceeding the time limit may result in penalty points.
9. The performance must be original, engaging, and well-structured.
10. Creativity and Catchy Slogan: The effectiveness of the advertisement in delivering a memorable and impactful message.
11. Humor and Engagement: The ability to capture the audience's attention in an entertaining manner.
12. Scientific Accuracy and Relevance: Proper representation of the properties and applications of the assigned dental material.
13. Use of Props and Visual Aids: Teams are encouraged to incorporate product packaging, models, or other relevant materials to enhance their presentation.
14. Clarity and Simplicity: The ability to communicate complex information in an easily understandable manner.
15. Team Coordination and Delivery: The overall coherence, teamwork, and stage presence of the group.
16. Any use of offensive language or inappropriate content will result in immediate disqualification.
17. Teams are responsible for bringing their own props and visual aids. Hazardous materials are strictly prohibited.
18. The decision of the judges will be final and binding.

Please Note : Delegates can not participate in more than one event per day

RULES AND REGULATIONS OF EVENTS

8. SOAP CARVING

1. This is an individual competition. Team entries are not allowed.
2. Maximum two entries allowed per college.
3. Participants must bring their own soap.
4. Carving tools must be brought by participants.
5. The use of additional decorative materials (paint, stickers, or embellishments) is not allowed.
6. The theme for the carving will be announced at the start of the event.
7. Participants will have to complete their carvings within 1 hour 45 minutes.
8. Participants must adhere to the time limit. Late submissions will not be evaluated.
9. Any form of plagiarism or copying from other participants will lead to disqualification.
10. Participants must maintain decorum and follow all event guidelines.
11. Carvings must be submitted at the designated display area before the time limit expires.
12. The decision of the judges will be final and binding.

9. FEEL AND FIGURE

Description:

Participants will be blindfolded and asked to identify a dental material or instrument solely by touch within the stipulated time.

1. One Participant per team.
2. Two teams per college.
3. Participants must strictly adhere to the time limit.
4. Any prompting or assistance from the audience will result in the disqualification of the respective college.

10. CROSSWORD COMPETITION

Topic: Dental Materials & Prosthodontics

1. The competition will be conducted for 15 minutes immediately after the lunch break.
2. Participation is individual only, team participation is not permitted.
3. The crossword will consist of clues related to Dental Materials and Prosthodontics.
4. Participants must complete the crossword on the provided sheet. Only one submission per participant is allowed.
5. Each correct answer will be awarded one point.
6. The use of mobile phones, books, or external references is strictly prohibited. Communication with fellow participants during the competition is not allowed.
7. The decision of the judges will be final and binding.

11. T-SHIRT DESIGNING.

Theme: Comic Strips related to Dentistry

1. Two teams per college.
2. Two students per team
3. Students must bring their own T-shirts (collarless)
4. Students must bring their own painting material.
5. The decision of the judges will be final and binding.

12. ART FROM DENTAL MATERIALS

Theme - Our Earth

1. Two teams per college
2. Two students per team
3. Students should bring their own material.
4. Students should report 15 minutes before event to venue and will be given 30 minutes to prepare their presentation.
5. Political messages will not be entertained.
6. The decision of the judges will be final and binding.

13. PHOTOGRAPHY

1. Participants must bring own DSLR camera on 20/06/2025.
2. Theme will be revealed at 9:00am.
3. Memory card used in camera must be devoid of old/previously taken photos.
4. Photos must be transferred to organisers laptop using the memory card from camera by 12 noon, 20/06/2025.
5. Edited photos will be disqualified.
6. Photographs taken on MOBILE PHONE CAMERAS will not be accepted.
7. The decision of the judges will be final and binding.
