Dr. Sanjay M. Mallya, BDS, MDS, PhD



Dr. Mallya is Professor and Chair of Oral & Maxillofacial Radiology at the UCLA School of Dentistry. He obtained his dental training and a Master's Degree in Oral Medicine and Radiology from the Nair Hospital Dental College, Mumbai; a specialty residency in Oral and Maxillofacial Radiology from the University of Connecticut School of Dental Medicine; and a PhD in Biomedical Sciences from the University of Connecticut. He is a diplomate of the American Board of Oral and Maxillofacial Radiology. He provides patient care in UCLA's Oral Radiology practice.

He has authored numerous scientific manuscripts and book chapters for major text books in Oral Radiology, Periodontology, Endodontology and Implantology. He is the editor for White and Pharoah's Oral Radiology, the premier textbook in oral radiology worldwide. He is active in organized dentistry. He is Past-President of the American Academy of Oral and Maxillofacial Radiology and served on the ADA President's task Force on Specialty Recognition and serves on the Interdisciplinary Affairs Forum of the California Dental Association. In addition to education, he is active in promoting quality care, and serves on the board for the Intersocietal Accreditation Commission. His current research is focused on imaging efficacy and quality. He has received grant funding from the NIH and private foundations.

Dr. Rajaram Gopalakrishnan, B.D.S., Ph.D.



Dr. Raj Gopalakrishnan is Professor and Director of the Division of Oral and Maxillofacial Pathology, School of Dentistry at the University of Minnesota. He is a diplomate of the American Board of Oral and Maxillofacial Pathology and a fellow of the American Academy of Oral and Maxillofacial Pathology. He has been at the University of Minnesota since 2002 and participates in an active surgical oral pathology practice (University Oral Pathology Laboratories). He also has an active research lab investigating the molecular mechanisms underlying BMP regulators and bone remodeling. More recently, his research interests have focused on understanding mechanisms that regulate early invasive phenotype in head and neck cancer.

He received advanced training in oral medicine from Eastman Dental Institute – London and Penn Dental school at University of Pennsylvania. He further undertook training in Special care dentistry at Morriston Hospital-Swansea, United Kingdom. His special area of interest in clinical teaching and research include dental care of special needs patients and medical management of immunobullous lesions.
