- Department of Anatomy

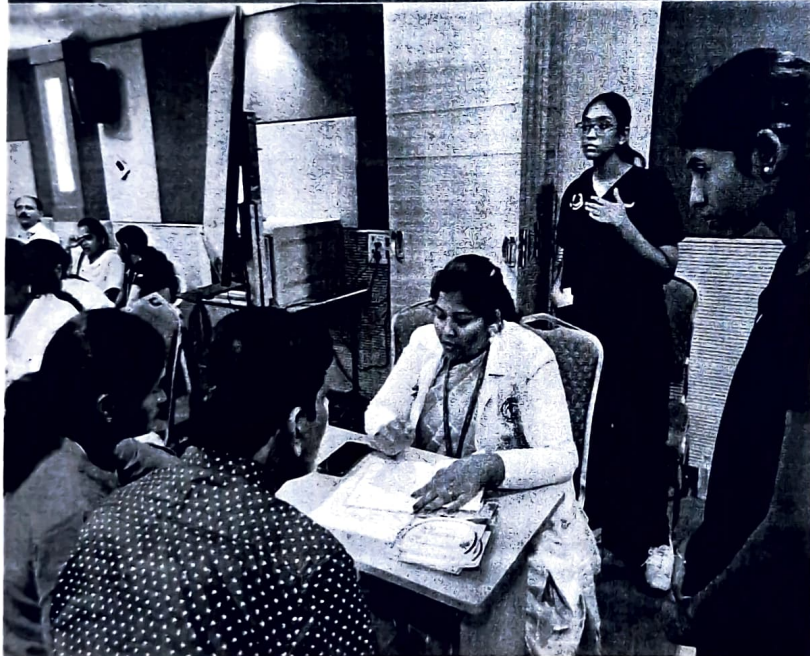
- Department of Physiology
